Garden Labels

Labelling in gardens has always been a difficult subject since economy and permanency do not coincide.

Wisley, Kew and other large gardens use engraved plastic laminate labels, either attached to the plant or on aluminium stems which are used at ground level. These are quite weatherproof but can become brittle in cold weather.

We also use galvanised stands for protection against rabbits and squirrels gnawing them. These labels are used in three sizes. The approximate sizes are: 106×71 mm (4 x 3in), 88 x 54mm (3½ x 2in) and 75 x 40 mm (3 x 1½in), and are fine for a public garden but possibly too obtrusive for a private one.

Small white plastic labels, used with a waterproof ink, cannot be considered permanent as both ink and plastic tend to

degrade after a year or two.

A paint marker, used on thicker plastic labels, will have a longer life. Waterproof marker pens are widely available, often from label suppliers.

Anodised aluminium labels are quite permanent, used with an HB pencil.

Embossed tape from machines such as Dymo can be very durable, provided it is attached to a completely clean, smooth surface such as plastic or aluminium.

Zinc labels, with names written in acid ink, are very long-lasting.

When hanging labels on trees and shrubs it is best not to use wire as it cuts into the bark. Ties of small electrical cable fixed loosely are better.
