B Y E - L A W S

as amended by resolution of the Committee  
made the 10th day of February 1959

---

1. That no persons be allowed in the enclosure, except those residing in the Square, their Children, Visitors and Servants.
2. That no Dogs be allowed in the Square, except led by a string.
3. That no wheeled vehicles of any kind other than Perambulators, Invalid Chairs and Gardening Equipment be allowed in the enclosure.
4. That no Hoops, Kites, Balls or other Games be permitted except Croquet.
5. That no Inhabitant, Servant, or other person admitted to the Square shall pick the flowers, walk on the Flower Beds, or commit any damage to the Trees, Plants, Shrubs, Seats, Tools, Tool House or Railings.
